The cream and black tiles glistened and the neon sign spelled out its welcome—it was September 1, 1938 and the new Lafayette Theater with its modern Art Deco design was opening! The line stretched down the block as people waited to see Errol Flynn and Olivia deHaviland in “Fours A Crowd”.

Now, almost 70 years later, people are again lining up for events at the Lafayette Theater. The large movie screen and stage are still in place, making it a perfect setting to enjoy a movie while having a drink, snack, and/or dinner. “Dinner & Movie” film series is featured throughout the year and include “classic” movies from years gone by or “Movies that Rock” & “Brew & View.” Refreshments are available and could include everything from a bag of popcorn, a slice of pizza to a catered meal, as well as wine, beer, sodas & cocktails.

Restored to its former glory, the theater provides the opportunity to return to the Hollywood glamour days. It is one of the few Art Deco style buildings in Lafayette’s historic downtown. The ticket booth, geometric design doors, refreshment stand, balcony, and original light fixtures allow you to experience the golden age of movie theaters. While the theater style seating is still available in the balcony, the main floor is now open with an area for tables, chairs, and a bar. The theater is available to rent for special events, proms, seminars, concerts, parties and receptions.
