

## Tropicanoe Cove at Columbian Park

Indiana is famous for hot summer days. But the Lafayette Parks and Recreation Department has found a way to “chill out” visitors. Tropicanoe Cove is a refreshing way for a family to take their minds off the summer heat.

From the 20 feet “funbrellas” providing shade between rides, to the eight water-filled attractions, this park offers something for everyone’s taste. Thrill-seekers will marvel at the 299 feet tube slide, called the Banana Peel. Brave participants ride an inflatable tube down this slide from the 34 feet tall tower. For those who prefer less speed,



Tropicanoe Cove has a lazy river ride named Cattail Crik. Four silent generators create this slow stream that allows you and your tube to take a relaxing trip around the aquatic center. Single and double tubes are available for all water attractions.

Tropicanoe Cove is one of the new additions to Lafayette’s historic Columbian Park. A bright, new, safe, and age-appropriate playground opened several years ago. Columbian Park and the zoo have been favorites in Lafayette for over 100 years and will continue so for many years to come.
